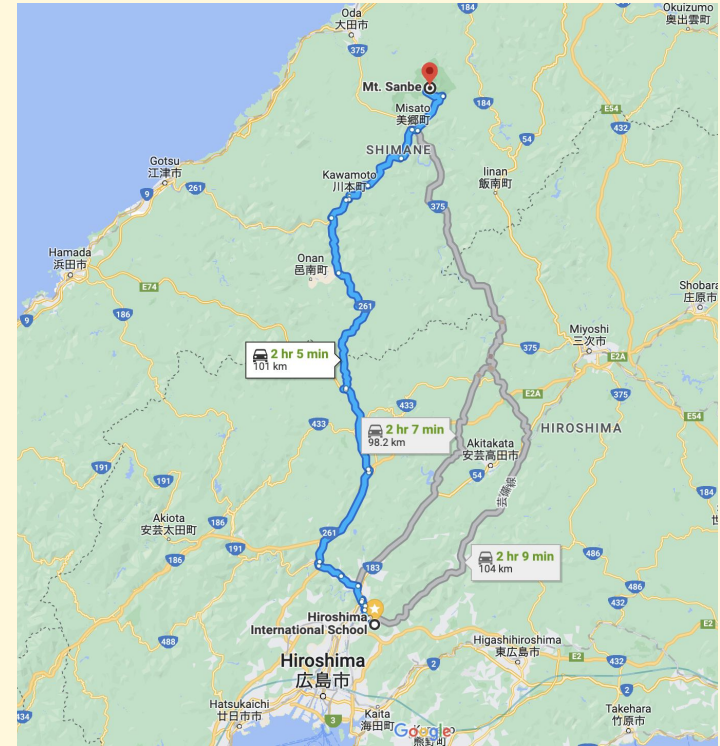
Recommended Packing List
